



# 2025 Mandarin Summer Camp

Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) of the National Taipei University of Education will organize and hold the Mandarin Camp in 2025. The program will provide youth and children with the opportunity to learn Mandarin and experience Taiwanese culture through all kinds of teaching activities during the camp.

## I. COURSE PLAN

1. Applicant: Children aged 6-11, teenagers aged 12-15 (by degree and age) (Subject to the number of applicants, the Centre reserves the right to adjust the course).
  2. Location: National Taipei University of Education. (No accommodation provided; If you have accommodation needs, we can provide information about the quality hotels nearby)
  3. Class Size: Each class will have a minimum of 8 students and a maximum of 12 students.
  4. Duration:
    1. Session I: 2025/06/23 (Monday) to 2025/07/11 (Friday)
    2. Session II: 2025/07/21 (Monday) to 2024/08/08 (Friday)
1. Class Hours: Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 15:30  
2. Application Deadline: From now until all sessions are full.

### III. TUITION

1. Price per session: USD 1,595 (Registration Fee: USD 35 + Tuition: USD 1,560)

2. Price per session: NTD 46,000 (Registration Fee: NTD 1,000 + Tuition: NTD 45,000)

\*Notice: The price of each session includes textbooks, materials expenses, lunch, dessert, transportation costs, entrance fees, meal expenses during field trips, and insurance. During the summer camp, each participant will be fully insured with travel safety insurance (accidental death insurance benefit of NTD 615,000).

**Please note that once paid, the registration fee cannot be refunded.**

### IV. DISCOUNT PROMOTION

**Each student is limited to only one discount option and has to complete the registration and payment during the promotion period.**

Option I: Early bird discount (price includes registration fee):

Those who register before February 28, 2025, only need USD 1,455/NTD 42,000 per person

Option II: Discount for old students (price includes registration fee):

Those who have signed up for our school's winter/summer camps only need USD 1,455/NTD 42,000 per person.

\*Please note which year the student participated in when filling out the application form.

Option III: Discounted price for new students recommended by old students (price includes registration fee):

If a former student recommends a new student and successfully registers, the new student will enjoy a NT\$1,000 discount, USD 1,560/NT\$ 45,000 per person

Option IV: Group discount (need to register and pay at the same time; price includes registration fee)

- Two (2) students: USD 1,525/NT\$44,000 per person
- Three (3) students: USD 1,490/NT\$43,000 per person
- Four (4) students: USD 1,455/NT\$42,000 per person
- Five (5) students or more: USD 1,420/NT\$41,000 per person
- Six (6) students or more: USD 1,385/NT\$40,000 per person

## VI. IMPORTANT NOTES

1. All times in this document are based on Taiwan's time.
2. Please be sure to read the "NTUE-CLEC Mandarin Camp Application and Payment Agreement" carefully, and submitting the application form means agreeing to the items contained in the Agreement.
3. Once you have been informed to make the payment for the program, you must pay the fee within five (7) working days or the student will automatically be taken out of the system and must start the application process over.
4. Please choose either USD or NTD to make the payment. The difference in exchange rates will not be refunded.
5. If paying by bank transfer, please indicate the participant's name when making the payment. After the transfer, please send an email to [ntuecleccamp@gmail.com](mailto:ntuecleccamp@gmail.com) with the participant's name, transfer date, transfer bank, and the last five digits of the account number. The center will confirm your payment via email within 7-10 business days after the payment.
6. Refund policy:
  - a. Apply before the program opening day, and 90% of the fee will be refunded. The registration fee will not be refunded.
  - b. Apply within the first 1/3 of camp days, and 50% of the fee will be refunded. The registration fee will not be refunded.
  - c. No refunds will be made if the application time has passed 1/3 of the camp days.
  - d. All refunds will be paid via bank transfer. Processing time is around one month.
7. Due to the impact of the pandemic, admitted participants are required to follow Taiwan's government regulations. Those who have a fever or respiratory symptoms must wear a mask throughout the camp. In case of illness or quarantine resulting in absence, there will be no make-up classes or refunds.
8. During the camp session, if there is a typhoon, earthquake, or other unavoidable natural causes, and the Taipei municipal government has announced that classes will be canceled that day, all activities and classes for winter camp will automatically be canceled. There will be no make-up classes or refunds for the canceled classes.
