Each of the tests listed below may be used to satisfy this option requirement. Below is a conversion chart to use to guide your data manager as to which proficiency level to enter and what will show on the student transcript.

The following table is a list of the DPI approved vendor exams, the minimum requirements for skills tests, and score report conversions.

As indicated on individual tests below, if there is no composite score, use the lowest score on the test that involves productive literacy (writing) and/or communication (speaking/signing) with others for the proficiency rating.
