Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language

TOCFL is a set of standardized language proficiency tests developed for non-native speakers of Chinese. TOCFL is divided into four sub-tests for listening, reading, speaking, and writing. Based on the CEFR standards, the speaking and writing test are divided into 3 Bands (A, B and C) and each Band is further divided into 2 levels for a total of 6 levels. The Steering Committee for the Test Of Proficiency-Huayu (SC-TOP) developed an entrance level Novice Band for beginners, which means the overall organization of four bands and eight levels.

Target Test Taker

TOCFL is designed to help Mandarin learners assess their language proficiency for study, work, or travel in Chinese-speaking contexts. Test-takers can choose a level that best suits their current Chinese language proficiency and learning background for each required skill.
