FSE English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI) Specialist & Teacher Trainer Program EMI Advisor Scholarship

Grant Description and Purpose

The FSE English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI) Specialist & Teacher Trainer scholarship program provides qualified EMI instructors or professors with the opportunity to spend 6 or 11 months as EMI Advisors and consultants for FSE / MOE EMI program participants who are teaching in EMI programs. Advisors also advise and supervise the teaching assistants in the English Teaching Flagship (ETF) program who are supporting and interacting with university students.

The program aims to enhance professional expertise through visits, observations, consultations, and coordination with Taiwanese universities that are internationalizing their academic programs. Advisors contribute to create a better EMI teaching and learning environment in Taiwan and help EMI instructors enhance the quality of the EMI courses.

Duration

The duration of the grant is 6 or 11 months beginning. With the Selection Committee's approval, renewal may be considered. The following are the duration dates of the grants.

- (1) Aug. 1st to June 30th of the grant year (11 months)
- (2) Aug. 1st to Jan. 31st of the grant year (6 months)
- (3) Jan. 1st to June 30th of the grant year (6 months)

Benefits

- Monthly stipend of NT\$65,000 NT\$90,000 (depending upon the qualifications of the grantee).
- Round-trip airfare between Taiwan and current residence (for non-Taiwan residents).
- A settling-in allowance of NT\$36,000 in the first month of the grant.
- National Health Insurance.
- Travel reimbursement for transportation costs incurred in traveling between locations; hotel reimbursement up to NT\$3,000 per night for business travel between locations.

- Workshops: For each 18-week semester, each advisor runs approximately 4 different weekday EMI workshops that focus on practical applications (rotating weekly among different locations).
- Reports: Provide written feedback on up to 16 American grantees' bi-weekly reflective reports.
- Teaching observations: Attend and comment on classroom observations each semester.
- Consultation: Provide individual advice to American grantees and EMI instructors and professors regarding teaching pedagogies and EMI teaching techniques and tips.
- Organize training forums and teacher training programs.
- Camps: Instruct the American grantees about the content of the English Camps in remote areas and their sites as part of American grantees' community service.
- Cultural Events: Participate in host family gatherings, Dragon Boat Festival, American grantees' school interviews, and so on.
- Office Hours: There is a requirement of checking in to the base offices approximately 3 days per week. If there is any in-person training session or team meetings, it is mandatory to participate.

ETF Application Eligibility

Nationality: Applicants must be US citizens.

Teaching Experience Requirements (meet one of the following):

One-month free housing (August, 2024)

- Applicants who have received the Fulbright ETA awards or ETF awards.
- Applicants who are currently teaching English in Taiwan or other countries.
- Applicants with at least one year of English-teaching experience.
- Applicants with a Master's degree in TEFL or English-teaching-related majors.
- Applicants selected from the affiliated universities with FSE.

Responsibilities & Expectations

Grantees in the FSE (Foundation for Scholarly Exchange) English Teaching Flagship Program may solo teach or co-teach with Taiwanese teachers in elementary schools, junior high schools, or universities with support from local coordinators and professional advisors.

The grantees will be invited to submit their preference for the locations they prefer; they are also welcometo continue their grant at the same site.

Locations: Taipei, New Taipei, Taichung, Changhua, Yunlin, Kaohsiung, Yilan, Hualien, Taitung, Kinmen, Penghu, Chiayi, Pingtung

- Summer Training: Assisting the training and other support for new ETAs and local teachers in August.
- Workshops: For each 18-week semester, each recipient will participate in at least 3 different weekday afternoon workshops and may be invited to share some teaching resources or teaching demonstrations.
- Reports: ETFs will submit at least 3 written reports per semester.
- Teaching Observations: Will be held at least once a year.
- English/Bilingual Teaching Forum: ETFs will be invited to organize training forums and teachertraining programs.
- Remote Service Camps: ETFs will be invited to assist and lead the ETAs to organize the content of English/Bilingual Camps in remote areas as community service.
- Cultural Events: ETFs will lead and explore the cultural activities in their communities.
- Community Service: ETFs shall complete eight hours of community service, which promotes person-to-person connections and genuine contributions to communities, each semester.

2024-2025 FSE English Teacher Trainer Program TEFL Advisor Scholarship

Grant Description and Purpose

The FSE English Teacher Trainer scholarship program provides qualified TEFL teachers or professors with the opportunity to spend one year as Academic Advisors for Fulbright English Teaching Assistants (ETA) and English Teaching Flagship (ETF) participants who serve at K-9 levels. Advisors work with the Americans and their counterparts Taiwanese Local English Teachers (LETs).

The purpose of the program is to enhance professional expertise through visits, observations, consultations, and coordination. By supervising these outstanding Americans and Taiwanese English teachers, the Advisors contribute to create a better English Teaching environment in Taiwan.

Duration

The duration of the grant is 11 months: August 1st, 2024 ~ June 30th, 2025
With the Selection Committee's approval, renewal for a second and final 11 months may be considered.

Benefits

- Monthly stipend of NT\$65,000 NT\$90,000 (depending upon the qualifications of the grantee)
- Round-trip airfare between Taiwan and current residence (for non-Taiwan residents)
- A settling-in allowance of NT\$36,000 in the first month of the grant
- National Health Insurance
- Travel reimbursement for transportation costs incurred in traveling between locations; hotelreimbursement up to NT\$3,000 per night for business travel between locations.
- The grant experience offers close professional interactions with Taiwanese TEFL teachers and local professors; recipients have many opportunities to travel around the island, visit major cities and see beautiful remote areas, including the indigenous areas.

• 10-minute Teaching Demo Video (optional)

To have the selection committee know you better, it is great to provide a 10-minute clip of your workshop if you like. It can be a demonstration of how you will teach your workshop or a recording of your real workshop. The workshop can be on any topic you think will be beneficial to the ETFs and ETAs. Your 10-minute clip/demonstration should be uploaded to your YouTube channel and provide the link.
