

2024 Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Frequently asked questions

- Q1: Can I submit application documents via email?
- A1: No, all applications must be sent in physical form to the Education Division of TECRO.
- Q2: How long is the term of the Huayu scholarship?
- Q2: 2 months (June to July or July to August), or 3, 6, 9, 12 months.
- Q3: I am a French national studying at Georgetown University. Where should I apply?
- A3: Residents in other states or nationalities, please check the Ministry of Education in Taiwan website to find the Education Divisions where you may apply. (http://english.moe.gov.tw/Home > About MOE > Overseas Offices)
- Q4. What's the award value of the Huayu Scholarship?
- A4: A fixed monthly stipend of NT\$25,000 with no other stipend.

(Exchange rate: 1 US = 30 NT)

Q5: Which language center can I apply to for admission?

Q5: HES applicants should apply for admission at language centers affiliated with universities approved by the Ministry of Education. An eligible language center list can be find on the website: lmit.edu.tw/lc/school list

Q6: When is the application period?

A6: February 1 to March 31 2024 (by postmark)

- Q7: I have been rewarded the Huayu Scholarship for two months before. Can I apply for this Scholarships this year again?
- A7: No. You can not apply for it again, no matter how long you have been awarded before.
- Q8: If I am awarded the scholarship for this academic year, but am unable to travel to

Taiwan as originally planned, can I delay to the next academic year?

- A8: No, the scholarship cannot be deferred.
- Q9: How will the scholarship be paid?
- A9: The stipends usually will be paid through the school at the end of each month. In principle, the scholarship is paid month by month. Each university has its own policy to distribute the scholarship to students. Please contact the coordinator at your school to know more details.
- Q10: Are there any requirements scholarship recipients must fulfill during their scholarship period?
- A10: Major requirements are listed below; additional details are in the MOE Directions.
 - The Scholarship will be suspended for one month, if the recipient has missed 12 hours or more of their language course within a single month.
 - Starting from the first semester (quarter), if the recipient fails to obtain the specified standard score by the university (an average of 80 points out of 100), his/her scholarship will be suspended for a month in the next semester (quarter).
 - The recipient fails to obtain the standard score for two consecutive semesters (quarters), he/she will be disqualified from receiving the scholarship.
 - Any recipient missing a final achievement score for any semester (quarter) will be disqualified from receiving the scholarship with the exception of a serious illness or accident.
- Q11: May I work to earn my living in Taiwan?
- A11: As an HES scholarship recipient, you are not allowed to work in Taiwan.
- Q12: How do I apply for a visa?
- A12: Contact the Consular Division of TECRO (https://taiwanembassy.org/us) for more information.
- Q13: Where can I find the test dates for TOCFL?
