# STUDENT FINANCE

#### PROGRAM COST

The CSAT program fee of \$7,950 will be taken out of student's normal U.S. tuition\*. This fee covers:

#### **TUITION**

Equivalent to 12 to 18 hours of coursework

#### HOUSING

Typical dormitory in host university

#### LANGUAGE INSTRUCTION EXPENSES

Equivalent to 3-6 hours of the U.S. semester credit within the 18 hours; often comes with a language partner

#### **CULTURE ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES**

Events organized by CSAT and/or the Taiwan partner institution

#### PRACTICUM EXPENSES

Fewer regular courses; replaced with a Teaching Practicum or Internship course. Includes supervision, reflection, and evaluation. Practicum & internship placements are limited and competitive.

### FACULTY INTERNATIONALIZATION INITIATIVE

For a U.S. institution enrolls <u>twelve or more (12+) students</u>, over a <u>three (3) year period</u>, one U.S. faculty member will be eligible for a fellowship. The benefits & responsibility include:

- 1. \$15,000 + housing
- 2. Teach one semester at a CSAT Taiwan partner university (selected by FSE & the U.S. institution)
- 3. Normal teaching commitment: 2-3 courses
- 4. Home institution encouraged to provide sabbatical or supplement

# FAQ

Q1: Do I have to be fluent in Chinese to study in Taiwan?

A: Not at all! Some Chinese will surely help you adapt to the life here, but our goal is to help you find English-taught classes that will fit your degree requirements or academic pursuits. We hope you will also want to study Chinese.

Q2: Will my home institution recognize the credits I take in Taiwan?

A: Your home institution always holds the discretion about whether they will accept the credits you earn in Taiwan. However, we work closely with both your home and host institutions to help facilitate the process. The plan is for it to be seamless. Before you come to Taiwan, we will provide a list of tentative courses that you can take, so you can provide their syllabi and other information to your advisors or your home institutions' academic offices for review. After the completion of your study here, we will facilitate translating your transcripts so you can report to your home institution for credit transfer. If your home institution is a Consortium member, it probably is automatic.

Q3: How is placement made? Do I get to choose where I will go?

A: Upon receiving your application, we will review your preferences, and then provide several schools that will best match your academic interest. Of course you get to make the final decision and you are also welcome to raise your concerns anytime during the process.

Q4: Is this program credible and safe?

A: Don't worry! CSAT is sponsored by both Fulbright Taiwan, recognized by the State Department, and FICHET, recognized by MOE. These are all credible official agencies promoting international higher education, so you do not have to worry about our reputation! The purpose is to get more undergraduates to study in Taiwan!

Q5: Besides the flat fee, is there any additional cost?

A: Please refer to the Student Finances for the detailed items covered by our service fee, including tuition and accommodation. Briefly, you still need to pay for the flight tickets as well as daily living expenses, just like in the U.S. However, Taiwan is a place enjoying high living standards at a reasonable cost. Specifically, good food is inexpensive, so don't worry about hidden charges. There are none!
