What is SUSI?

- A 5 to 6-week academic program (summer and winter).
- For multinational groups of university faculty from abroad.
- Take place at university campuses throughout the United States.
- 18 to 30 foreign educators participate in each program.
- 4 weeks for academic seminar and 1 to 2-week for study tour.
- Programs sponsored by the U.S. government.

Themes in SUSI

SUSI is to strengthen curricula and improve the quality of teaching about the United States in academic institutions overseas. Topics of SUSI programs include:

- Religious Freedom and Pluralism in the United States
- American Culture and Values
- US Foreign Policy
- Journalism and Media
- US Economics and Business
- Secondary Education
