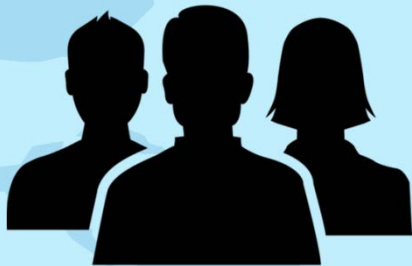

1. Introduction and objectives
