# **Chinese Language Education Award at MaFLA**

# I. Award Category

- A. Outstanding New Teacher Award
- B. Outstanding Chinese Teacher Award
- C. Lifetime Achievement Award
- D. Outstanding Advocacy Award
- E. Teaching Service Award

#### II. Criteria

# A. Outstanding New Teacher Award

- 1. This applicant has been teaching in K-12 public or independent schools for less than 5 years.
- 2. S/he is currently teaching at a full or a half-time position.
- 3. S/he must demonstrate excellence and passion in teaching Chinese language and culture.
- 4. This award consists of a plaque in recognition of his/her excellence in teaching, a scholarship amount that is equivalent to a one-year MaFLA membership and the MaFLA Conference registration fee.

## B. Outstanding Chinese Teacher Award

- 1. This applicant is currently in teaching practice and has held a full-time position for at least 5 years.
- 2. S/he has demonstrated excellence in teaching Chinese language and culture to students at K-12 schools.
- 3. This award consists of a plaque in recognition of his/her excellence in teaching and a scholarship amount that is equivalent to a one-year MaFLA membership and the MaFLA Conference registration fee.

#### C. Lifetime Achievement Award

- 1. This award recognizes an individual of the Chinese teaching profession who has demonstrated prominent long-term achievement and service to the profession locally, statewide, regionally, and/or nationally.
- 2. Chinese teachers of PreK-12 in the New England area are eligible to apply for this award.
- 3. This award consists of a plaque in recognition of his/her lifetime contribution to the field and two luncheon tickets to the Awards Ceremony at MaFLA.

#### D. Outstanding Advocacy Award

1. This award recognizes an individual or an organization outside of the Chinese teaching field that has made a significant contribution and service to the K-12 Chinese teaching profession.

- 2. The nominee must be instrumental in performing advocacy functions in supporting the teaching of K-12 Chinese programs.
- 3. This award consists of a plaque in recognition of his/her advocacy in promoting the teaching and learning of Chinese and two luncheon tickets to the Awards Ceremony at MaFLA.

## E. Teaching Service Award

- 1. This awardee(s) has/have committed to teaching Chinese language and culture and has/have made a milestone this year for the 10<sup>th</sup>-, 15<sup>th</sup>- and 20<sup>th</sup>- year in either a public or private school.
- 2. This award consists of a personalized certificate recognizing the years of service in the field of Chinese language teaching.

#### III. Nomination

# A. Outstanding New Teacher Award

- 1. Self-nomination or nomination by others (school administrators, etc.) are accepted.
- 2. A cover letter of personal info and a current CV.
- 3. A recommendation letter from candidate's direct supervisor.
- 4. A one-page professional statement regarding Chinese teaching philosophy and approach, and students' learning outcome.
- 5. Awardee will be decided by the Award Committee.

## B. Outstanding Chinese Teacher Award

- 1. Self-nomination or nomination by others (school administrators, colleagues, etc.) are accepted.
- 2. A cover letter of personal info and a current CV.
- 3. A letter of recommendation from nominee's direct supervisor.
- 4. A one-page professional statement of teaching philosophy, approaches of teaching culture, and students' learning outcome.
- 5. Awardee will be decided by the Award Committee.

#### C. Lifetime Achievement Award

- 1. Nomination from the field.
- 2. Awardee will be decided by the Award Committee.

### D. Outstanding Advocacy Award

- 1. Nomination from the field.
- 2. Awardee will be decided by the Award Committee.

#### E. Teaching Service Award

- 1. Self-nomination
- 2. A written document of years of service from the school.
